November 4 - Joseph's Dream (Genesis 37:5-11, 19-21, 23, 24,28) - Joseph announced his dreams of greatness to his father and already jealous brothers. The brothers plotted to kill him, but rather than being racked with guilt of his blood on their hands, they sold him into slavery

November 11 - Joseph's Dream Began to Come True (Genesis 41:25-40)- Pharaoh had a dream that was puzzling to him. God gave Joseph the ability to interpret Pharaoh's dream to mean that the land would experience seven years of abundance and seven years of famine. Joseph offered Pharaoh a solution, and in return, Pharaoh elevated Joseph to a position of power, which is what Joseph, himself, dreamed.

November 18 - God Preserved a Remnant (Genesis 45:1-12) - Joseph identifies himself to his brothers and realizes that the events in his life - specifically their selling him into Egypt - were part of God's great plan to preserve a remnant of the family of promise. God worked out for good what Joseph's brothers meant for evil.

November 25 - Jacob Blessed His Family (Genesis 48:11-19) - Jacob moved to Egypt to live out his last days. There he pronounced blessings on Joseph's sons, Ephraim, and Manasseh, giving the younger son, Ephraim, a greater blessing. Jacob's blessing continued the line of descendants promised to Abraham and Sarah.
