## The Pastor's Pen

There are times when decisions made by our government make us proud. On August 25, 2009 one such decision was made.

After consultation with Secretary of the Interior Ken Salazar and the governor or chief executive of each host jurisdiction, Secretary of the Treasury Timothy F. Geithner approved a recommendation to feature significant historical sites on the United States Mint's America The Beautiful Program. The following comes from a newswire statement forwarded to me by Deacon Charles Smith.

*WASHINGTON, Sept. 9 /PRNewswire-US Newswire/ -- The United States Mint announced today that the nation will honor the Tuskegee Airmen National Historic Site in Alabama through its new quarter-dollar coin program. The Tuskegee Airmen design will be the 56th to be featured on coins released under the United States Mint's America the Beautiful Quarters Program, and will be issued in 2021.*

*In the late 1930s, the U.S. government created civilian pilot training programs throughout the country to provide a surplus of pilots in case of a national emergency. African Americans were included in these programs, although trained at segregated facilities. These Americans' love of flight became fully ablaze amid World War II as political pressure challenged the government to expand the role of African Americans in the military. The Army Air Corps was the first agency to accept the challenge. Tuskegee Institute, a small black college in Alabama, was selected to host the "military experiment" to train African American pilots and support staff -- thus the Tuskegee Airmen were born. The outstanding performance of the more than 15,000 men and women who shared the "Tuskegee Experience" from 1942-1946, is immortalized at the Tuskegee Airmen National Historic Site. It was established as a national site in 1998.*

One man made an astonishing announcement. He and both of his brothers had recovered from the disease. Early detection is the reason they survived.
